Proposed Construction of 8 no Dwellings together with all associated site development works at Cross West, Cross, Co Mayo.

Pursuant to the requirements of Section 179 of the Planning and Development Acts, 2000-2020 and Part 8 of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001-2020, notice is hereby given that Mayo County Council proposes to carry out a development, particulars of which are set out in the Schedule hereunder.

Location	Nature and Extent of Development
Cross West, Cross, Co Mayo	Proposed Construction of 8 no Dwelling Units comprising 3 no. 3 bed dormer scale houses and 5 no. 2 bed dormer scale houses with private rear gardens. All associated site development works including demolition of existing roadside wall, provision of new entrance from public local roadway, internal access roads, footpaths, parking, public lighting, landscaping, associated earthworks, utilities, services connections (including connection to public water mains approx. 300m to the east of the site), new drainage with connections to public mains and associated ancillary works at Cross West, Cross, Co Mayo.
