L-1120, The provision of footpath and kerbs along the eastern side of Belleek Road, from the Gate Lodge to the 50kmph Speed Limit. To include the relocation of fencing and removal/replacement of trees as necessary to facilitate works.<li data-bbox="363 1346 1501 1406">2. L-11205 construction of a car park and pedestrian link to the existing off road footpath network in Belleek.
