Proposed Public Realm Improvement works at Main Street and adjoining road junctions, Newport, Co Mayo

Pursuant to the requirements of Section 179 of the Planning and Development Acts, 2000-2020 and Part 8 of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001-2020, notice is hereby given that Mayo County Council proposes to carry out a development, particulars of which are set out in the Schedule hereunder.

Schedule

Location	Nature and Extent of Development
Main Street, and connecting road junctions, Newport, Co Mayo	The works consist of a series of measure to improve both the safety and quality of the public realm on Main Street and at adjoining junctions. Measures include the provision of; traffic calming, one way system on Castlebar Street up to viaduct, accessible designated parking spaces, zebra and pedestrian crossings, clear delineation of roadway, parking and loading spaces, widened repaved footpaths and paved and landscaped public spaces.
