Before making its decision on an application to confirm the Compulsory Purchase Order, the Bord must consider any objection(s) made and not withdrawn, any additional submissions or observations made pursuant to a request by the Bord under Section 217A of the Planning and Development Act, 2000 (as amended) and in the event of an oral hearing being held, any report of the person who conducted the hearing.

An Bord Pleanála may confirm the Compulsory Purchase Order or any part thereof with or without modified annul the Compulsory Purchase Order or any part thereof.

A person may question the validity of any decision by An Bord Pleanála to confirm a Compulsory Purchase Order by way of an application for judicial review, under Order 84 of the Rules of the Superior Courts as provided for in Section 50 of the Planning and Development Acts 2000-2021. 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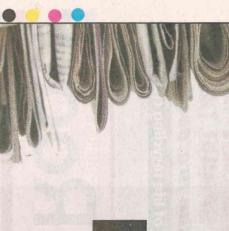
