## **Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Screening Determination**

### **Mayo County Council – SRTS R1 Brackloon NS**

Moore Group Environmental Services was commissioned by Tobin's on behalf of Mayo County Council to prepare an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Screening Report for the proposed SRTS R1 – Brackloon NS development. The Proposed Development aims to improve safety for pedestrians and cyclists at front of school, along L1822 at Brackloon, Co. Mayo, through enhanced active travel infrastructure. The Project aligns with the SRTS Outline Delivery Plan. The works at front of school will be focused on slowing traffic, improving visibility of the school and reducing congestion at the entrance to the school, to provide safer access for students. Along with front of school measures, the project will include a junction upgrade to the East of the school, encouraging slower vehicle speeds further improving pedestrian and cyclist safety.


The EIA Screening examined whether the Proposed Development necessitates the undertaking of a full EIA and subsequent publication of an EIA Report (EIAR) as required under Directive 2014/52/EU, and considered the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 (as amended) and Section 50 of the Roads Act 1993 (as amended). A review of the characteristics of the Proposed Development, the location of the Proposed Development, and the characteristics of potential impacts was undertaken based on Schedule 7 of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 (as amended).

The EIA Screening Report concludes that the Proposed Development does not exceed the thresholds that would trigger a mandatory requirement for a full EIA and subsequent preparation of an EIAR, and is therefore deemed to be a sub-threshold development. Nonetheless, a sub-threshold EIA Screening was prepared to establish whether there are likely significant environmental effects from the Proposed Development on the receiving environment with regard to Schedule 7A and Schedule 7 of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 (as amended). The EIA Screening concludes that the Proposed Development is unlikely to result in significant adverse environmental effects, either individually or in combination with other projects given the type, size, scale, and location of the Proposed Development; the characteristics of the receiving environment; and the implementation of standard and best practice mitigation measures during construction.

No likely significant effects have been identified during the screening process and, as such, a full EIA culminating in the preparation of an EIAR is not required.

Mayo County Council, having considered the EIA Screening Report, has determined that the SRTS R1 – Brackloon NS development does not require full EIA.
