Renovation work to a seawall along the R313 at the location known locally as Bundola in the townlands of Curraghboy, Rinanagh and Drumreagh, Belmullet, Co. Mayo

Curraghboy, Rinanagh and Drumreagh, Belmullet, Co. Mayo.	Renovation work to a seawall along the R313 at the location known locally as Bundola. Renovations will comprise of the replacement /raising of the existing wall parapet together the construction of a new concrete render on the seawall.
