

## Appropriate Assessment Screening Determination

### **Project Description**

Emergency renovation work to a seawall along the R313 at the location known locally as Bundola.

Renovations will comprise of the replacement /raising of the existing wall parapet together the construction of a new concrete render on the seawall.

### **Appropriate Assessment**

In accordance with Article 6(3) of the Habitats Directive, the proposed development must therefore be screened for the need to undertake an Appropriate Assessment and a full Appropriate Assessment undertaken should the screening show that significant effects are likely on designated site/s or where there is uncertainty regarding the potential for, or significance of, impacts on the designated site/s.

### **Appropriate Assessment Screening Determination (Stage 1):**

Having regard to the Appropriate Assessment Screening Report carried out for the project for which this Part 8 application and to the information on the Part 8 application file, which is considered accurate in order to issue a screening determination.

Mayo County Council considered that the proposed development, individually and/or in combination with other plans or projects would not be likely to have a significant effect on any European site, in view of the site's conservation objectives, and a Stage 2 Appropriate Assessment (and preparation of a NIS) is not therefore required.
